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Sports Premium Funding Report

The London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games gave us a once in a lifetime opportunity to inspire the nation to enjoy sport and develop healthy lifestyles. The government is determined to secure a significant and lasting legacy from the Games and introduced new funding arrangements for schools from September 2013 to improve the quality of sport and PE for all primary aged children.

(£9,765 in total is allocated this year.)

We are using this to enhance the quality and breadth of our PE provision for Newbarn's pupils by:

- Hiring specialist coaches with exemplary knowledge and practical skills to work alongside class teachers to improve PE teaching and learning, ensuring a breadth of disciplines are covered, therefore ensuring all PE lessons are of the highest quality.
- Increasing participation in school sport by running additional after school PE clubs.
- Increasing participation in school sport by funding and supporting structured play activities at lunch and break times. (Active Playground Encouragers (APE) Club.)
- Providing opportunities for more children to participate in sporting tournaments and fixtures.
- Providing quality supply cover to enable staff to support sporting events and tournaments.
- Ensuring that transport costs, where needed, are covered.
- Providing extra equipment (with a ten year guarantee) for children to play with at playtimes and lunchtimes.

We are confident that pupils will benefit as a result of this enhanced funding. Already, more children have been introduced to a wider range of after school sports and in school coaching. An analysis of the full impact on children's ability in physical education is completed annually. This shows an increase in the number of children achieving at or above age related expectations for their year group.
